

Requirements for up to 4<sup>th</sup> kyu will be consistent with the Standard Shotokan grading syllabus. The differences start from 3<sup>rd</sup> kyu as follows.

<p><b><u>3<sup>RD</sup> KYU</u></b> Brown belt</p>	<p>The, the same as Standard Shotokan <b>PLUS</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Bunkai</b> of any kata chosen by the examinee</li> <li>• <b>Special Applications</b> examinee's choice of a few techniques studied in the final term</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>2<sup>ND</sup> KYU</u></b></p>	<p>The same as Standard Shotokan <b>EXCEPT FOR Jyu ippon Kumite, Replaced with:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Bunkai</b> of the katas studied in the final term</li> <li>• <b>Special Applications</b> out of those that are studied and pointed out during the final term</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>1<sup>ST</sup> KYU</u></b></p>	<p>The same as Standard Shotokan, <b>EXCEPT FOR Jyu ippon Kumite. Replaced with:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Bunkai</b> of the katas studied in the final term plus, one Kihon kata chosen by the examinee</li> <li>• <b>Special Applications</b> out of those that are studied and pointed out during the final term</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>SHODAN</u></b> Black Belt</p>	<p>The same as Standard Shotokan <b>EXCEPT FOR Jyu Kumite, Replaced with:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Bunkai</b> of all Kihon katas</li> <li>• <b>Special Applications</b> out of those that are studied and pointed out during the final term</li> <li>• <b>Limited Jyu Kumite</b> e.g Arms only, Legs only or one side defense and one side offence</li> </ul>
<p><b><u>NIDAN</u></b> 2<sup>nd</sup> dan</p>	<p>The same as Shodan <b>EXCEPT for Jyu Kumite replaced with:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Bunkai</b> of one advanced kata chosen by the examinee, plus any application from the kihon kata chosen by <i>examiner</i></li> <li>• <b>Special Applications</b> those studied and pointed out during the final term</li> </ul>
